April 1 to 5, 2026



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The LADIES CARAVAN adventure Rally will take place in Morocco, starting from Marrakech, from April 1st to 5th, 2026. Multiple landscapes, each more different than the last, will be crossed to provide an extraordinary adventure. You will traverse mountains, oases, desert, and dunes for a complete change of scenery.

This 4x4 Rally is an adventure challenge that combines tracks and roads with stages and points of interest, in a spirit of discovery and adventure. At the end of each Sector, each crew can gain or lose points. The ranking is based on the precision of mileage and the validation of Check Points, not on speed: points-based ranking. At the end of this challenge, during the awards ceremony, the top 3 crews will receive a trophy.

Cap Sector (orientation) : The route book for the "Cap" sector indicates the sequence of check points (CPs) to reach "on Cap" by trying to go the shortest way, i.e., progressing optimally in the direction of the cap. Generally, CPs must be completed in the imposed order from 1 to "x". The objective is to achieve the shortest distance between CPs, and any CP not validated between the departure and arrival of the Cap Sector incurs a penalty (additional points). A CP is validated by punching a pass (using a specific punch at the CP).

Roadbook Sector : Stage sections based on a Roadbook Sector consist of strictly following the roadbook instructions without getting lost, in order to complete the "typical" route defined by the Organization between departure and arrival. Each roadbook note indicates either a change of direction or heading, or information about danger or other. Any navigation error and/or misinterpretation of the roadbook can cause the crew and their vehicle to deviate from the ideal route determined by the roadbook, and thus travel hundreds of meters or additional kilometers.

Convoy or Free Sector (non-classified) : During the Raid, certain stage sections will be completed in convoy or freely with a GPS track. One or more groups of vehicles may be formed with an organization vehicle in the 1st position and a closing vehicle.

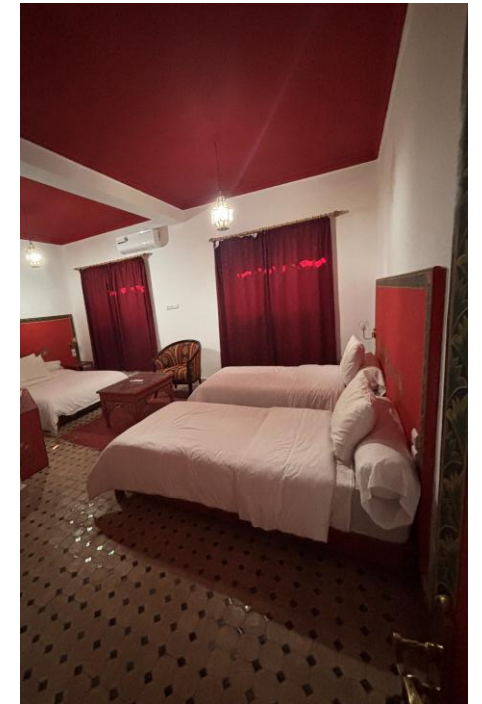
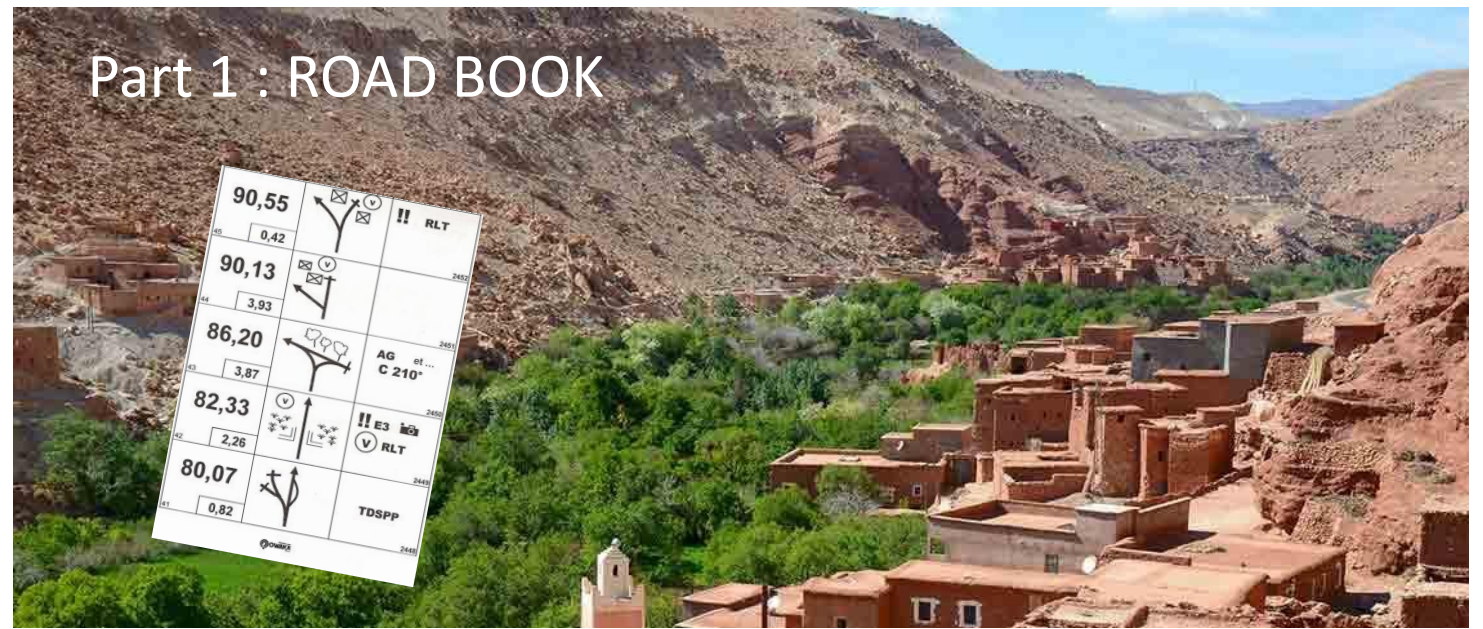

05:00 PM: Arrival at the bivouac at the foot of the dunes

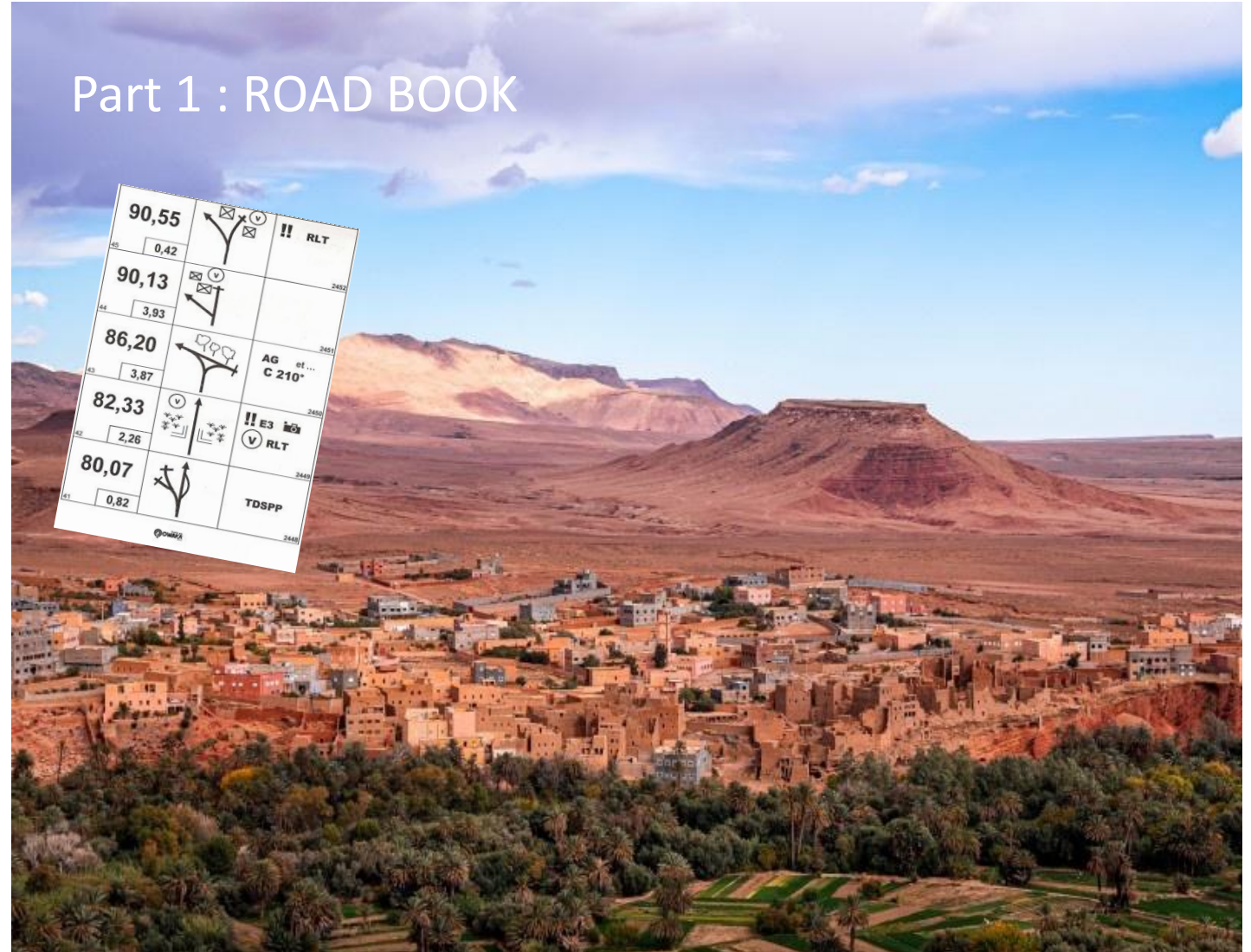

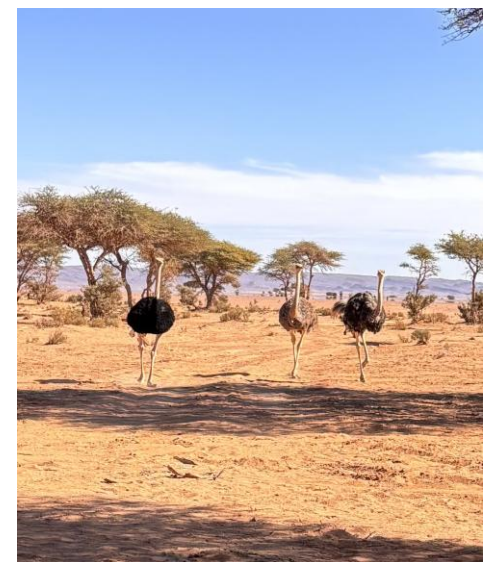
